Based on children’s interested “questioning”, children are supported to explore the learning concept and the interrelationships among the related concepts situating in the context of concrete activities. Through facilitating self-reflection, children are assisted to construe the meaning of experiences and reconstruct knowledge by a process of concept mapping. When children gain an adequate understanding of the learning content, and grasp the interrelationships among the concepts, it is found that under the guidance of teachers, young children are capable of weaving a self-initiated concept map, which logically presenting a knowledge structure.
